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How we started the road to sounds...

- The first cochlear implant: March, 2000 in Iași
- The Cochlear Implantation Programme has been operating since 2004
- Universal neonatal hearing screening was introduced in 2015
- Cochlear implantation centers: 8
- Sound Processor Replacement programme from 2019



National Advocacy – with small steps



- 2016 the first step for Perspective Association for Hearing Impaired Children in Romania
- 2017- the second step: workshops, meetings with families and professionals, conference
- Founding a support association for the Hungarian parents: Hallóka
- The first joint advocacy action with all associations in the field for Sound Processor Replacement Programme
- 2018 the biggest step: The first meeting of associations: "How to Build a Non-governmental Organization"
- 2019 workshops
- 2020 National conference of associations that support hearing impaired people in Romania with participation of Cochlear Implant Centers and Universities
- Perspective magazine

- Negotiations with the National Health Insurance House as regarding the refund of auditory-verbal rehabilitation therapies, insuring the post-warranty reparations as well as consumables for the devices
