


Sue Archbold and Beatrice Cusmai: Advocacy and no budget?

PRESS RELEASE TO HAVE A WORLDWIDE COMMUNICATION:

 We could write a short press release with 4/5 key messages from WRH

IF WE CREATE A TEMPLATE OF PRESS RELEASE

- Every country can adapt it, but at least the 4/5 key points can circulate all over the world, with the same message.
- We need Key points to share for this the new resources from CIICA give us these!
- And you will have resources to support you our summaries of the evidence.



Use the template to reach the national and local press in your country.



- Try to reach NATIONAL and LOCAL press. Local press is important to create a network and to become "outstanding" and to be recognised as an "expert"
- Example of CIICA press release delivered to press the day before World Hearing Day
