Hearing loss affects: individual, family, society


Personal experience: denial → sadness → adaptation


Every story is unique → holistic approach

- enhanced spatial orientation




Life gains new dimension!

Practical strategies

- Simple apps, clear instructions, and daily routines
- Support between generations and help from mentors
- Add new features slowly and celebrate small successes
